What can be done for Jesus, through just ONE man still remains to be seen. We have driven through ten states and logged over 6000 miles on the Lord's car. Just before we left for the USA in August, we held the funeral of Bro. Raymond. He was the one who had three operations on his liver. Praise the Lord he got saved in January 2004. At the funeral about forty people were present, two came to the Sunday service the following weekend. One of them was gloriously saved. So I told this dear brother Sunday you'll have a new name now - Sunday-Sunday - because you were born into the human family on Sunday and into God's family on another Sunday. He smiled from ear to ear - isn't God great?

Gordon Pulley (with the SMORS program), is doing a fantastic job filling our shoes. He preaches 3 times in the German language and one in English. He with our church people in Munich is continuing the Gospel distribution and visitation ministry. Four weeks 'Renee' came to the service as a direct result and one week ago she gotten saved and has attended every service since. What a blessing the attendance of the two churches continues to grow.

The two of us (my Sandy and me) are healthy and we thank the LORD and you for all your unselfish prayers in our behalf. Please continue to pray that the LORD will provide open doors for us to minister while we are here in the USA. Please pray that Gordon Pulley with continue with our folk's reach more souls in Germany. Thank you for your support.
