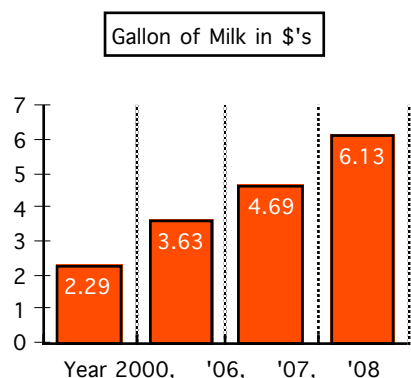
### Serving in Spain



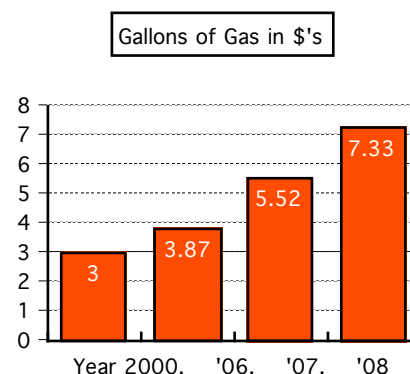
Dear Pastor and Church family,

We are not complaining (as the financial crisis is worldwide and many who are having a bigger struggle than we are), just asking you to pray for God's provision in the coming months.
