The orphanage children were in church on Sunday. What a blessing. There were so many children at church that we needed to split them up into two groups. Praise the Lord for that problem. Ha-ha Judy and I took the littler group and I really enjoyed it. One of the little girls from the orphanage was found in her home by herself, tied to a cold radiator and beaten. She had been there they said for 4 days. Her name is Christina (4yrs.). She doesn't talk much but has a pretty smile. I took several pictures and so did Judy. We tell you about a lot but to be able to see the people we are talking about would help you more, I think. But the price of getting it designed is pretty expensive. Her father is Russian, so she is studying Russian here in hopes to work in interpreting for maybe government type things. Her father is Russian orthodox and her mother she said was very liberal, which she said she got most of her thinking from. Tony spoke to her about the Lord that evening but she kept changing the subject. We invited her to church a couple times and then Vansant's did that evening. So please pray that she will come and also pray especially for her salvation.

A couple in the church had been in America for some time visiting and just returned this passed week. Everyone was so happy to see them. They brought candy from the states for all the children. Let me tell you, the children where so excited, even mine. They ran up to tell me that they each had a Reese's in their bag. Ha-ha They just better eat it before daddy sees it. Ha-ha
