- 3) Phase 2 medication is now being applied, and it is working.
- 4) sandy has an appointment for a progress check at the Clinic at the end of March.

The doctor has assured us, that this procedure will help Sandy. If the operation would have been done in Germany, the Cleveland Clinic specialist said, "Sandy would have developed other future problems and these we are trying to avoid if possible" - the words of the doctors.

We thank you for your prayers and consider this the answer from God for the present time. I have rescheduled my flight back to Munich, Germany, Lord willing, for the 10th of March. Sandy will follow as she continues to recover at the end of April. Please continue to pray for Sandy's complete recovery.

While here waiting, I had the privilege of preaching at the church (Toledo Baptist Temple, Toledo, Ohio) where I got saved in 1963 and also at our sending church (New Hope Baptist Church, Ft. Wayne, Indiana). They both were a blessing to us. According to our phone conversation, both churches in Munich are doing well.
