

Plans:

The Lord has called me to start a Biblical New Testament church in the city of Jerusalem, Israel.

Two thousand years ago Jesus wept over this city for the need for people to come to repentance. And He is still weeping today. "...But how shall they hear without a preacher..."

Jerusalem is seven miles north of Bethlehem, with a population of about 670,000. There are only eleven thousand born again Jews and Arabs in the country where our Savior walked. The country of Israel is dominated by the three main religions of the world Islam, Judaism, and Catholicism.

Yet with the country's population being six million there is no true testimony for Jesus.

I believe God is going to raise a living testimony through the preaching His word and the winning souls to the Lord Jesus Christ. I had the opportunity to grow up in the country and experience the language and culture first hand. I saw many come to Christ, which even burdened my heart for the people more and more. In fact, after the murder of my uncle on the Mount of Olives by fanatics, God showed me that those who murdered my uncle need the Gospel. I asked God, "Where do you want me in the Country?" "So God turned my eyes to Jerusalem and to the truth that both the Jews and the Gentiles need the Gospel of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

So God has given me this burden and a mission with it. I found that we need about 1,500,000 dollars to purchase one acre of land and build a building. I need, by God's help and grace and your prayers, to have the land to start the work. It is a challenge that is given to all Christians around the world to reach the Jews and the Gentiles.

My prayer as you read these words is that whatever you do to help us, it will be an inspiration and encouragement to those who are interested in the souls of the people of Israel.
