Children's Camp at Mount Calvary Baptist Youth Camp. We began the week with 95 campers. On Tuesday afternoon (were you praying for us?) a nasty storm hit the camp. The children were listening to the missionary story, as the adults watched the storm rage around us and prayed. One of the girl's cabins (where the girls had been just 15 minutes earlier) lost its roof. Praise God no one was hurt and the damage is in the process of being repaired. Five children (4 boys and 1 girl) made a public profession of faith.

Van Request. The time has come to replace our van (many, many miles of use as a mini-bus for church and for hauling things to camps). Junior Camp: Juan and Maria Esther Alvarez (mexican missionaries to the Basque in northern Spain) did a great job preparing this camp, where we had a total of 62 in attendance. The juniors were challenged to "Dare to live your life for Christ" and we saw 4 make a profession of faith. We received news after children's camp, that Cecilia (age 9) from the Canary Islands, accepted the Lord as her Saviour. The fruit from summer camps is harvested throughout the year in the Baptist Churches scattered across Spain!

Faithful Prayer partner: When we began serving the Lord as missionaries in 1981, Bro. Cal Eastwood invited us to the church in Rensselaer, IN. He and his wife, Leota, treated us like family, took us on for support and promised they would pray for us daily. Bro. Cal wrote many letters, encouraging us during times of trials on the field. His last letter written to us on Jan. 26, 2004 states, "I send my love and promise of daily prayer." (signed) Bro. Cal. In June we received a letter from his daughter telling us of his home going. Beverly wrote, "Rejoice in knowing that your prayer partner is now interceding with the Lord in person!" Bro. & Mrs. Eastwood were a precious gift in our lives and ministry. May God give us many more faithful and loving prayer partners (like Bro. Cal) to intercede on behalf of souls in Spain!
