It has always been our prayer and desire to influence those around us to a closer walk with Jesus Christ. WOL gave us the chance to do just that on a large scale.

We would like to thank Mike Calhoun and Word of Life for the opportunity to serve in such a dynamic ministry. It has been a privilege to server with a staff of Godly people who have a great passion for the things of Christ. We love WOL and I suppose we will always be "Word of Lifers."

One thing that must not go without saying, is the importance of raising our kids as missionaries with WOL. We could not begin to list the names of people who have impacted our kids for Jesus. The principles and passion they have learned has been invaluable.

Why the Change?

For a few years now, I have thought about being in a pastor/teacher role. Opportunities have come up but I never had a peace about leaving WOL. In fact, until last year I never imagined doing anything but WOL, I enjoy it that much. After our anniversary trip back to Hawaii in February 2003 I started to think about moving back. Cindy however was not ready to leave the kids, grandkids and our ministry with WOL, so I basically forgot about it. At Christmas time, Cindy told me the Lord had given her a peace about going to Hawaii for ministry. Then I started to think about it seriously again and went into my "Talk God out of it" mode. I asked God, "Why I would want to leave a ministry I love where things are going

rather well, leave our family, leave the St. Louis area where we had just moved, to move 5000 miles away to do something I have never done before, like plant a church?" Thus began a period of wrestling with God. The more I prayed the more I wanted to go and I begged God to show me what to do. To which I think He was saying, "I'm trying." Once I said yes I would go, I had complete rest and peace. God was moving us into a new ministry.

Do you know anyone on the Big Island?

Not a soul. I have spoken with 2 pastors on the Island and they are looking forward to us coming.

Are there many churches there?

Not really, just a handful.

Can we come and visit?

Absolutely! We are looking forward to guests from the mainland

Are you going through a mission board?

No. We are being sent as independent missionaries through:

Fellowship Baptist Church in Mt. Zion, IL

They will handle our spiritual & ministry accountability.

Will you still need Support?

YES! We will continue as faith based missionaries

How will your support be handled?

Central Missionary Clearinghouse of Houston, Tx will process our finances. They will issue tax deductible receipts each month. They also provide financial accountability for IRS concerns.
